

This was the first formal Fan Advisory Board (FAB) meeting since the departure of Susan Whelan, and it took place just a few days after Khun Top's video communication to fans.

The report from the meeting shares an overview of the discussions we had about issues such as developing the away priority points scheme, the development of a supporter group network and season ticket holder attendance at both men's and women's matches, as well as an early conversation about setting season ticket prices for next season. But we know that what matters most to us as fans at the moment (beyond results on the pitch, of course) remains the rebuilding of the club and its relationship with us as fans. So we wanted to use this opportunity to provide an update from our perspective about what we can see happening.

As a group we were able to hold an online meeting with Top in the days before his video was released, giving us an opportunity to both listen to his views on the club's recent history and provide some initial fan feedback direct to the owner. Top has indicated his keen-ness to meet with us again, and we found him to be very open to working with us. While not unheard of, it's not particularly common for club owners to meet directly or regularly with their club's Fan Advisory Board and so this feels promising.

Top's passion for Leicester City and his desire to see us winning football competitions came through loud and clear during that first conversation and we feel we can assure everyone that his commitment to the club and to our success – both on and off the pitch - is not in any doubt. He shared some of his thinking with us about the strategic changes he is looking to make in order to re-set the club, and was clear about his intention to ensure a turn-around in our footballing fortunes.

While the footballing turn-around we all want to see *is* a priority for the club and is being acted on, it is also clear the club expects it is something that will take time to achieve.

As fans, we believe we can help make this happen by coming together and getting behind the team to create an atmosphere that gives everyone confidence and belief. Success is never guaranteed, but it's easier to achieve when we are together.

While we feel we can look forward to the future with some optimism, the fan members of the FAB also want to take this opportunity to look back and put on record their thanks to Susan Whelan for the incredible leadership she gave Leicester City over 15 years, and for the simply unprecedented achievements that we experienced under her leadership.
