Final Reminder: Extra Points Opportunity

If physician and practice level VBR are both completed by 1/1/2026, your practice will earn 5 extra credit points on the VBR scorecard!

These points can be used to increase your practice's score up to 100 points. Practices who go over 100 points will not receive additional value based reimbursement.

- Practice-level users:** “MCT2D Practice Performance Reports” (left-hand menu)


Report Availability



Performance Measure Notes

- uACR (PCP & Nephrology) and CGM Interpretation (Endocrinology) are **process measures**
- Early performance may be **lower than baseline** and is expected to improve over time

HEDIS Update

- **PCP HbA1c HEDIS targets** not yet released by NCQA
- Performance targets will be shared once received

- Next progress report: **March 2026**
- Patient Data Dashboard updates:

 - **Jan 30, 2026:** Data through 11/30/2025




Performance Report Feedback Survey


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CGM Coverage Loss Survey




