SUPPORTER MESSAGE

As we prepare for Thursday's fixture in Budapest, we want to ensure you are well informed for your trip. We have been in dialogue with Football Supporters Europe and other clubs to understand previous experiences at this stadium, and we appreciate Ferencvárosi's cooperation and acknowledgement of the feedback we have shared on behalf of supporters.

Across the continent, the Rangers support are renowned for their incredible backing both in noise and in colour.

Supporters are, however, reminded the club remains under a suspended stand closure sanction. That means should there be any repeat of what UEFA deems as 'racist and/or discriminatory behaviour', it could lead to further sanctions and a full stand closure.

In addition, the club is under a suspended away section ban which will be triggered if pyrotechnics are used at future fixtures. Should this occur, it would result in Rangers supporters being locked out of a key away match, directly impacting those who travel in such numbers to follow the team.

Both sanctions mean thousands of fellow Rangers supporters could be deprived of the opportunity to attend important games, while the players on the pitch would lose a significant proportion of the amazing support you provide.

Discriminatory behaviour includes (but is not limited to) illicit singing, chanting, or the displaying of banners.

We call on all our travelling support to back the team in the right manner and prove once again what a force for good the Rangers support can be.



TICKETING

- There will be a full ticket collection for this fixture, with members of the Rangers Ticketing Team in attendance to facilitate it.
- The ticket collection point is at the recommended area for our supporters – [Bálna Budapest](#).
- Tickets will be available for collection on matchday between 11:30 and 16:00 (local time).

- To collect your match ticket, you must present the ticket voucher sent to you in advance – which includes your name and passport number – along with a valid form of photographic ID.

Copies or photos of ID will not be accepted.
- You must keep your voucher after collecting your ticket. Your voucher, match ticket and photographic ID are all required to board the shuttle buses and to enter the stadium.
- Please note that you will only be able to collect your own ticket, and no other supporter can pick it up on your behalf.



RECOMMENDED SUPPORTER AREA

- Supporters are recommended to gather at [Bálna Budapest](#), situated on the Danube riverfront, which is the location of the ticket collection. This is the site of a military museum, which we ask supporters to be mindful of.
 - This area has various bars and restaurant and is well connected to the city centre by tram (closest stop: Zsil utca), taxi and by foot. The closest Metro station is Fővám tér, situated on Line 4.
- Take care outside the bars at Bálna, as a cycle lane runs through the area, with cyclists and electric scooters passing through regularly.
- Ráday Street, located a 10-minute walk away, is a popular alternative, with plenty of cafés, bars and restaurants.
- Supporters should avoid the areas around the stadium, including Népliget Metro Station (Line 3), the wider Népliget area (including bars Szöglet Presszó and Zöld Villám), and the section of Üllői út near the "Eagle" statue.



HOW TO GET TO THE STADIUM

- Supporters are required to travel to and from the match using free shuttle buses for safety reasons. These will depart from and return to, [Báňa Budapest](#).
- In order to board the buses, you will require your ticket voucher and match ticket.
- ID checks will be carried out by local authorities before boarding the buses, checking details against ticket vouchers.
- Six shuttle buses will be in operation, with the service expected to start around 16:30 (local time).
- The journey is expected to take around 15 minutes.
- Buses will drop off directly outside the away end.
- No alcohol is permitted on board.
- Please note, Rangers Football Club will be liable for any damage to the shuttle buses.



STADIUM & ENTRY DETAILS

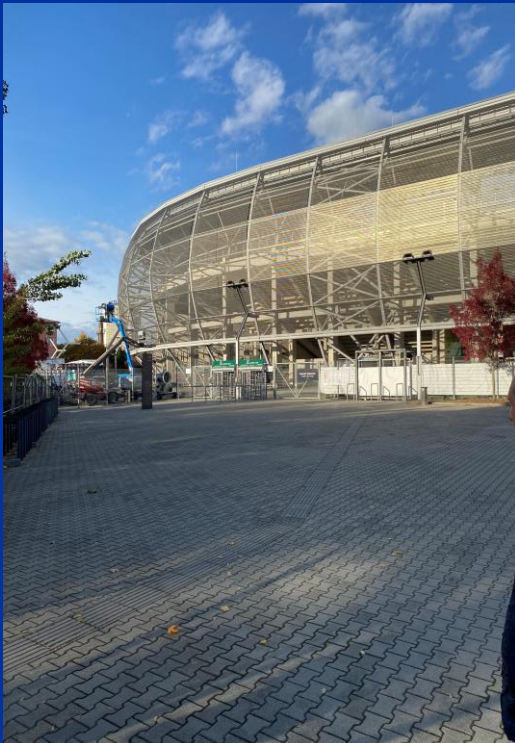

- The stadium will open two hours before kick-off.
- Our supporters will be situated in section E, with access via four turnstiles.
- Supporters should be prepared for ID checks at the stadium, which will be verified against the personal details on the ticket voucher.
- Supporters who have any accessibility requirements should email disabilitymatters@rangers.co.uk as soon as possible.
- It is estimated there will be a holdback of around 30-40 minutes at the end of the match to allow the stadium footprint to clear before our fans can board the shuttle buses.



ENTRY DETAILS

- Flags must be submitted for approval before Wednesday 10 December. Please email your request, including a photo and dimensions, to slo@rangers.co.uk. If you have submitted your flag for a previous fixture, you are not required to re-submit it.
- We have been advised that battery packs will be permitted, but they should not exceed the size of your phone.
 - Bags should not exceed 20cm x 20cm x 30cm.
- There is limited storage available at the stadium on a first-come, first-served basis. This is only for small prohibited items i.e. no suitcases or large bags.
- Various refreshments will be available inside the stadium, including 5% alcoholic beer.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Passport Requirements

Hungary follows Schengen area entry rules. Your passport must have been issued less than 10 years before your arrival date and must be valid for at least three months after the day you plan to leave the Schengen area. If your passport was renewed before 1 October 2018, check carefully, as it may have a date of issue that is more than 10 years ago.

New European Union Entry/Exit System

From 12 October 2025, the EU began to introduce a new Entry/Exit System (EES) for travellers entering the Schengen area. On your first trip after this date, you may need to register biometric details (photo and fingerprints) at a designated booth before immigration. The process is free, and children aged 11 and under will only have their photo taken.

This may add a few minutes to border checks while the system is rolled out, and passports will continue to be stamped during the transition. Once fully implemented, EES will replace manual passport stamping with biometric records.
