for the Use of the Contact Tracing Application

1 Scope of Application

We offer our clients - service providers such as restaurants and hotels - contact tracing, a digital application to contribute to the protection and health of our fellow men but also as a preventative measure to prevent or contain diseases that result from the transfer of viruses. It simplifies and accelerates the tracing and identification of persons who had been in contact with each other in case such an infection occurs. On the one hand, we offer this service because of official regulations but also - independent of official regulations - to be able to contribute to the containment of diseases that are spread by viruses at any given time.

The use of this application necessitates the storing and processing of personal data. For the purpose of storing and processing said personal data, we are in compliance with the applicable provisions in accordance with the **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)**.

The responsible party for the storing and processing of personal data is **Alturos Destinations GmbH, Lakeside B03, A-9020 Klagenfurt**.

3 Information Concerning the Processing of Your Personal Data

The application necessitates the disclosure of the following personal data (master data):

- First name
- Last name
- Telephone number
- E-Mail address

In addition, it is also necessary to disclose the number of one's accompanying persons.

We will store the data as long as the statutory provisions or regulatory orders, respectively, stipulate. Without any such statutory provisions or regulatory orders, respectively, the personal data are deleted after 14 days.

4 Rights of the Persons Affected

4.1 With Regard to your Personal Data, You Are Entitled to the Following Rights:

- Right to access data (Art 15 GDPR),
- Right to rectify (Art 16 GDPR) or delete data (Art 17 GDPR),
- Limiting the processing of data (Art 18 GDPR),
- Right to data portability (Art 20 GDPR),
- Right to object to the processing of data (Art 21 GDPR).

4.2 Right to Revoke

If you granted us permission to process your personal data, you can revoke your permission at any time. Your revocation shall not affect the legality of the previous data processing that took place until said revocation. Should data processing continue to be necessary because of statutory provisions or regulatory orders, we shall continue to do so.

4.3 Right to Object

Should the processing of your personal data be based on a balancing of interests (Art 6, paragraph 1 lit. f GDPR: legitimate interests), you have the right to object to the processing of data at any time for reasons that arise from your particular situation. When exercising your right to object, we ask that you state your grounds why your personal data should not be processed by us. We shall examine the situation and either stop the processing of data, customize it or show you our compelling legitimate grounds – i.e. statutory provisions or regulatory orders - and continue processing your data. We shall also continue processing your data if this serves the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.

4.4 Exercising Your Rights

4.5 Complaints to the Supervisory Authority

In addition, if you believe that the storing and processing of your personal data violates current data protection laws or that your data protection aspects are being infringed upon, you have the right to raise a complaint to the supervisory authority.
