This subject allows students to apply their knowledge and skills in a clinical placement at Endeavour's facilities. As junior acupuncture practitioners, they work in pairs with senior student mentors under the supervision of qualified practitioners. Students alternate roles as lead and supporting practitioners, engaging in peer-based learning and assessment. They develop their skills in acupuncture, Chinese remedial massage, herbal medicine, and other therapies, while receiving feedback from supervisors, patients, and peers. There is increasing emphasis on evidence-informed, patient-centred care, and understanding the role of Chinese medicine within a broader healthcare model, particularly in managing straightforward patient cases.
