Subject overview

This subject offers students the chance to apply their knowledge in a clinical placement. CMCP412 students work as junior Chinese herbalism practitioners, paired with senior student mentors and supervised by qualified practitioners. They alternate roles as lead and supporting practitioners, engaging in peer-based learning and assessment. Students refine their skills in acupuncture, Chinese herbal medicine, remedial massage, dietetics, and other therapies, while receiving feedback from supervisors, patients, and peers. The focus is on developing an evidence-informed, patient-centred approach to Chinese herbalism and understanding its role within an inter-professional healthcare model.
