The Chinese Clinical Medicine stream uses a case-based learning model to enhance students' clinical reasoning and application of Chinese medicine principles, including pattern and disease differentiation (respectively, bian zheng and bian bing). Students will integrate various diagnostic frameworks and therapies, combining Chinese and biomedical approaches to manage internal medicine conditions within an inter-professional healthcare model. The subject covers digestive, hepatic, endocrine, reproductive, urinary, and lymphatic systems, promoting evidencebased Chinese medicine practices. Students will evaluate health research and apply acupuncture, Chinese remedial massage (tui na), herbal medicines, dietetics, and lifestyle therapies in their practice.
