Subject overview

The main objective of this first clinical practicum is to foster teamwork among junior and senior student practitioners, under the guidance of clinic supervisors. Junior student practitioners will be active participants in most of the facets of clinical practicum. This includes observing and undertaking consultations with the public, reception, and dispensary duties, gathering clinically relevant client data, and working through the research requirements for ongoing client management and treatment efficacy. Students will be required to reflect on their clinical practice skills and their experiences in clinic and to take active responsibility for continued learning and development and improving their clinical practice skills.

This subject is clinical practicum undertaken in a working clinic, treating clients from the general public. To prepare the students for professional practice, this subject requires the student to maintain 100% attendance across the on-campus timetabled clinic sessions for the full 12 weeks.
