SECTION 1: PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is the expectation that the Graduate Medical Education (GME) Office maintain a policy regarding professional activities outside the educational program per Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) Institutional Requirements.

SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY and SCOPE

- 2.1 This policy applies to all Fellows in training programs at Hoag Memorial Hospital Presbyterian.

SECTION 3. POLICY

Policy on Extracurricular Activities (Moonlighting)

- 3.1 Hoag Memorial Hospital Presbyterian considers graduate medical education to be a full-time educational experience. Consequently, fellows should not be diverted from their primary educational responsibilities, and in no instances are fellows permitted to engage in extracurricular patient care activities (“moonlighting”).
- 3.2 Fellows who engage in moonlighting may be subject to dismissal from their training program at Hoag Memorial Hospital Presbyterian.
