

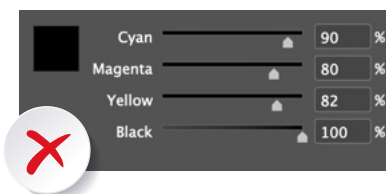
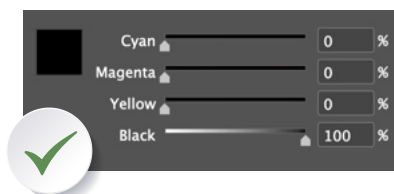

How to correctly prepare artwork for print

Setting up artwork

Ensure artwork for NCR content is set up correctly by using **only PANTONE colours**. Pantone colours are standardised colours that are able to be referenced and replicated exactly. Any artwork supplied in RGB or CMYK colour format will be rejected by our workflow. We support printing of 1 or 2 spot colours within your designs.

If you require black ink on your NCR pad, please ensure the colour is **100% black** and not a black composed up of 4 colours (CMYK) – shown in the images to the right. Artwork supplied this way will be rejected by our workflow.



Numbering & perforation

If you require perforation or numbering, please show this on a second page of your PDF. For perforation, mark the required edge with a dotted line and allow a 20mm safe area from the edge of the page. For numbering, indicate the exact position and confirm the starting number.
