


Otto's Tales: Today Is Columbus Day!

Travel to 1492 and discover how curiosity, determination, and perseverance helped make America possible.




Otto's Tales: Let's Visit the Hoover Dam

Otto and Smidge meet new, hardworking friends at the dam who help them learn the reward of teamwork and giving their best effort.




Otto's Tales: Let's Visit Mount Rushmore

Otto and Smidge discover the importance of not giving up, even when things get difficult, while they learn about great U.S. presidents who shaped America through their leadership.




Otto's Tales: Let's Visit the Statue of Liberty

Teach young learners the importance of freedom with this storybook about the Statue of Liberty.




Otto's Tales: Today Is Flag Day


Otto's Tales: Let's Meet a Librarian

Otto's Tales: Let's Meet a Volunteer


Receive an age-appropriate introduction to the Holocaust and learn key American values like patriotism, gratitude, and the importance of volunteering in our communities.



Otto's Tales: Let's Meet an Engineer


Readers will learn the importance of making a plan, being precise with details, and not giving up, while appreciating the values of tenacity and excellence.






Trailblazers: Lewis & Clark

Head west with Captains Meriwether Lewis and William Clark, the men assigned to map vast miles of new American soil by President Thomas Jefferson.




Trailblazers: Heroes of the Frontier


Street Smarts Workbook 1

Packed with facts and fun to teach students about important figures and U.S. Presidents often mischaracterized or forgotten in today's classrooms.




The Tip-Off (The Chronicles of Jonathan Spencer, Book 1)

A funny and relatable coming-of-age novel that helps kids navigate friendship shifts, self-doubt, and discovering what they truly love—both on and off the court.




Around the World: Communism & Freedom of Speech – North Korea & Hong Kong
