Daycare Injury Risk

Daycare for dogs is really not that different from daycare for children. During active play it is possible for injuries to occur. Some dogs may play a little rougher than others, and at times even tempers can flare in the most docile of dogs.

Dogs will often vie for status. We do have the occasional argument between dogs. Normally, this consists of a lot of noise and slobber. When we do have an argument, our staff has been trained to use safe and effective ways to break up different types of arguments.

As a result, it is important to understand that while these incidents are not an everyday occurrence, they do occur and are generally minor in nature. The most common injuries we see are minor cuts and punctures to the ears. Although these bleed, they are fairly minor injuries and require minimal attention for proper healing. Treatment normally consists of a visit to the vet for professional observation and assessment. Generally, the wound will be cleaned and stitched or glued if necessary, with a follow up round of antibiotics to prevent infection.
