Build the Relationship Over Time

Step 1 Know Their Names...kids and pets too.

Step 2 Offer Hospitality - welcome them into your yard or home. Have treats on hand for a pet (or kid).

Step 3 Ask Their Story - Ask great questions like, what brought you to the neighborhood? What was your family like growing up? What is satisfying about your work? Do you have family in town? Build over time with 5 minute conversations.

Step 4 Serve them - Look for a home project or a seasonal chore they may allow you to help with. Is there a time you can support them in sickness or when they are out of town? Pull their trash cans off the curb early in the day.
